City Council Proceedings
March 24, 2026

A Cody City Council Work Session was held in the Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Tuesday, March 24, 2026 at 5:30 PM.

Council President Shreve called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Council Member Shreve, City Administrator Tony Tolstedt, and Public Works Director Phillip Bowman provided updates regarding various projects, task forces, and committees.

Tina Gail, Administrative Services Officer, presented information to the Governing Body regarding a request to allow the Cody Farmers Market to use the Bob Moore Parking Lot from May through September 2026. Staff was directed to place this item on the April 7, 2026, meeting agenda for Council consideration.

Macie Hopkins, Cody Country Chamber of Commerce Special Events Coordinator, provided the Council with a request for the upcoming events: May 30th (Cody Conservation Street Dance), June 4th (Block Party - North 13th Street between Rumsey and Sheridan Ave) June 11th (Block Party - North 15th Street between Sheridan Ave and the alley before Rumsey) and July 1st - July 4th (Wild West Arts Fest).
